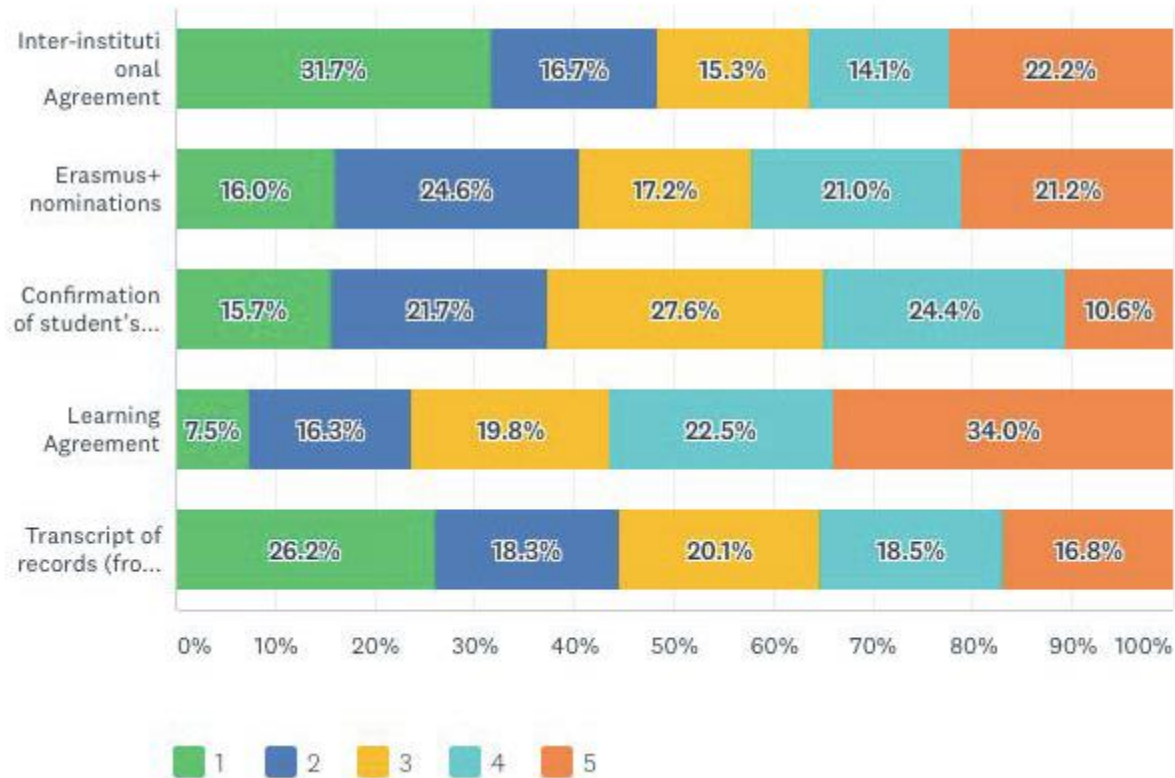

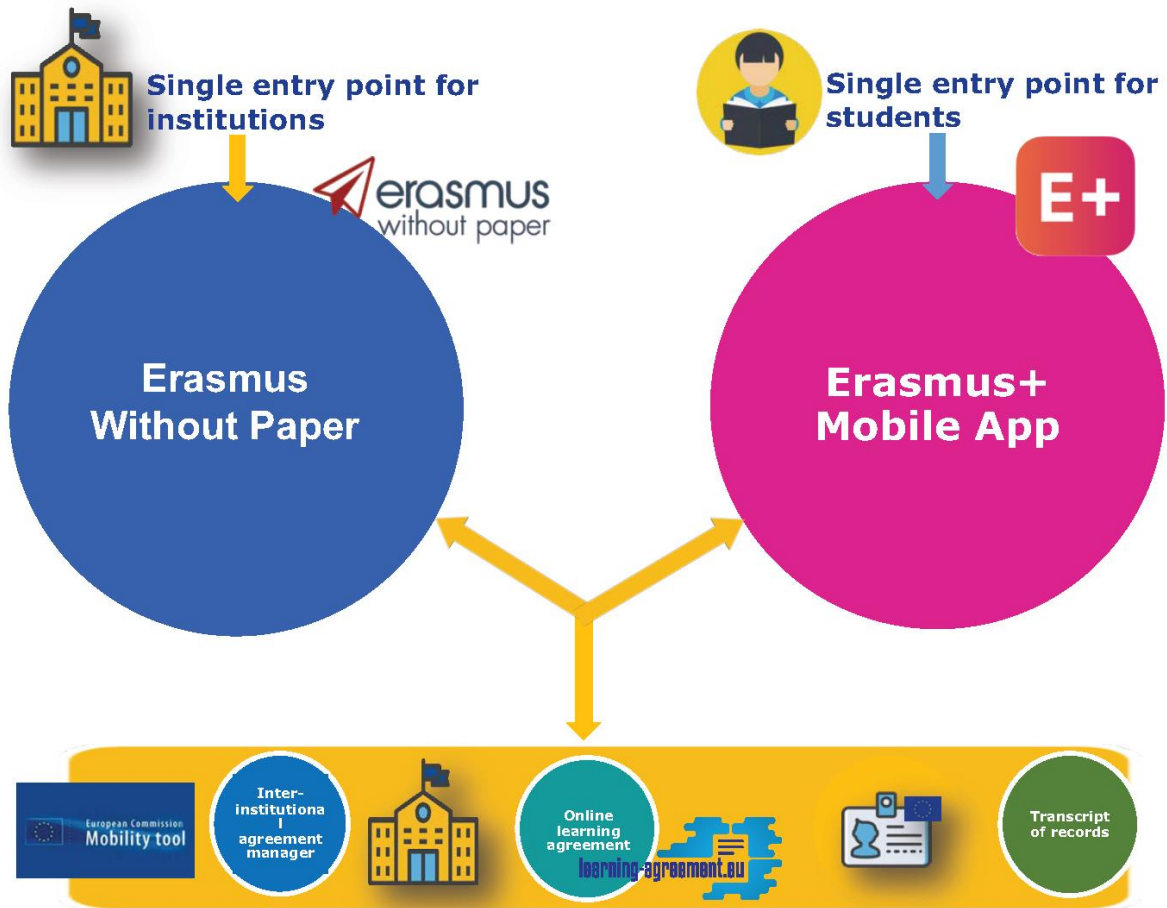


The EWP standards will become gradually mandatory from 2021

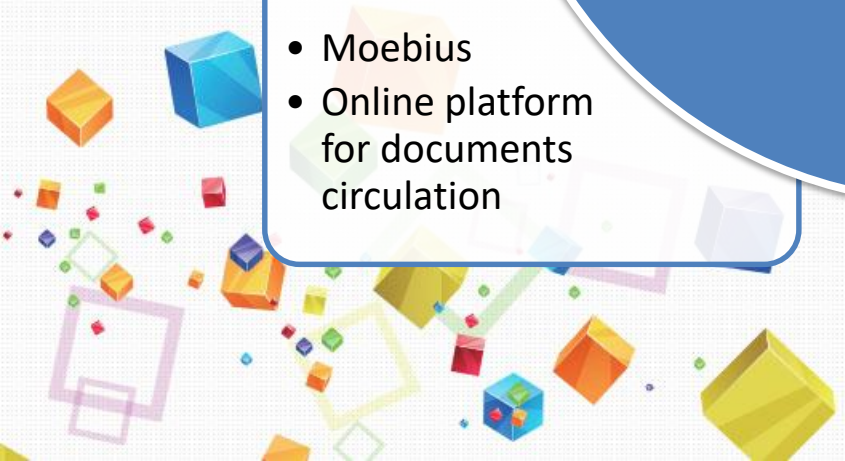
