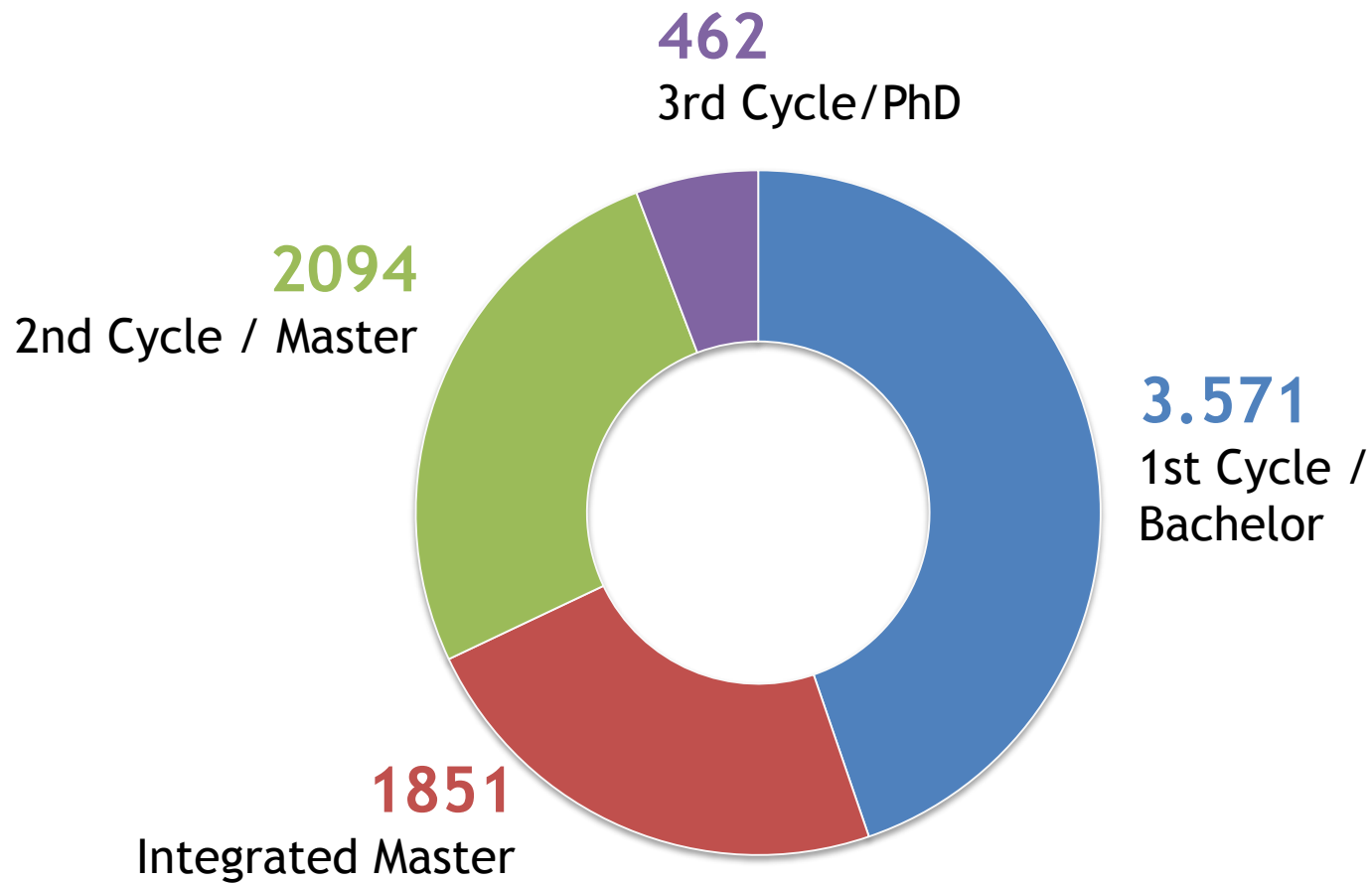

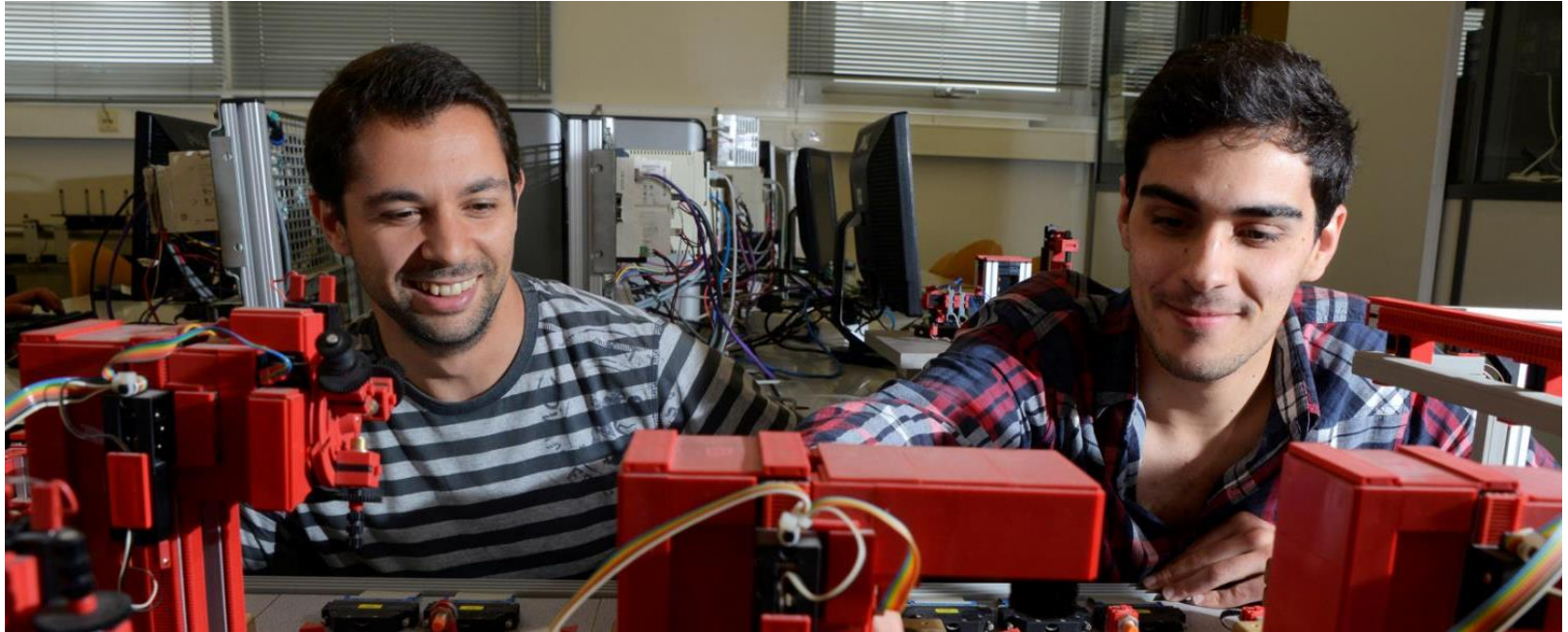

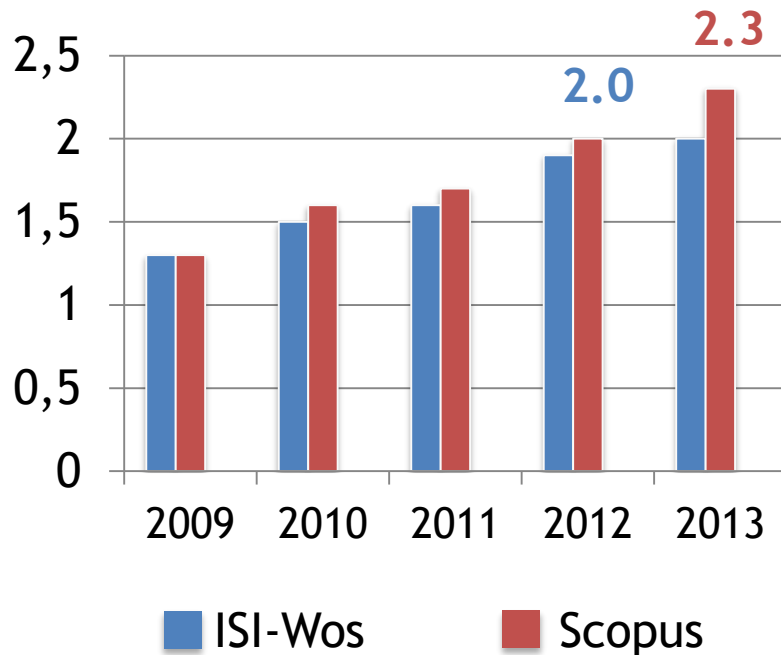

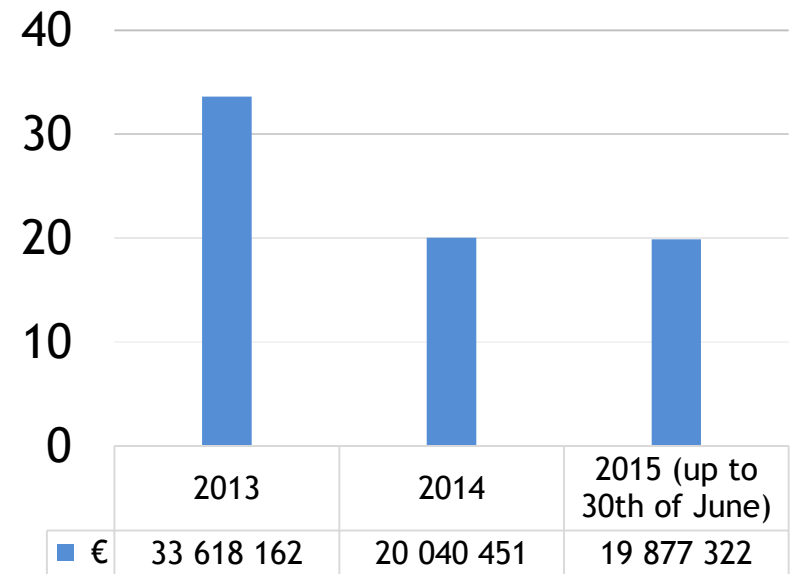
The largest producer of Science in Portugal

Funding from R&D projects 2013-2015 (million €)



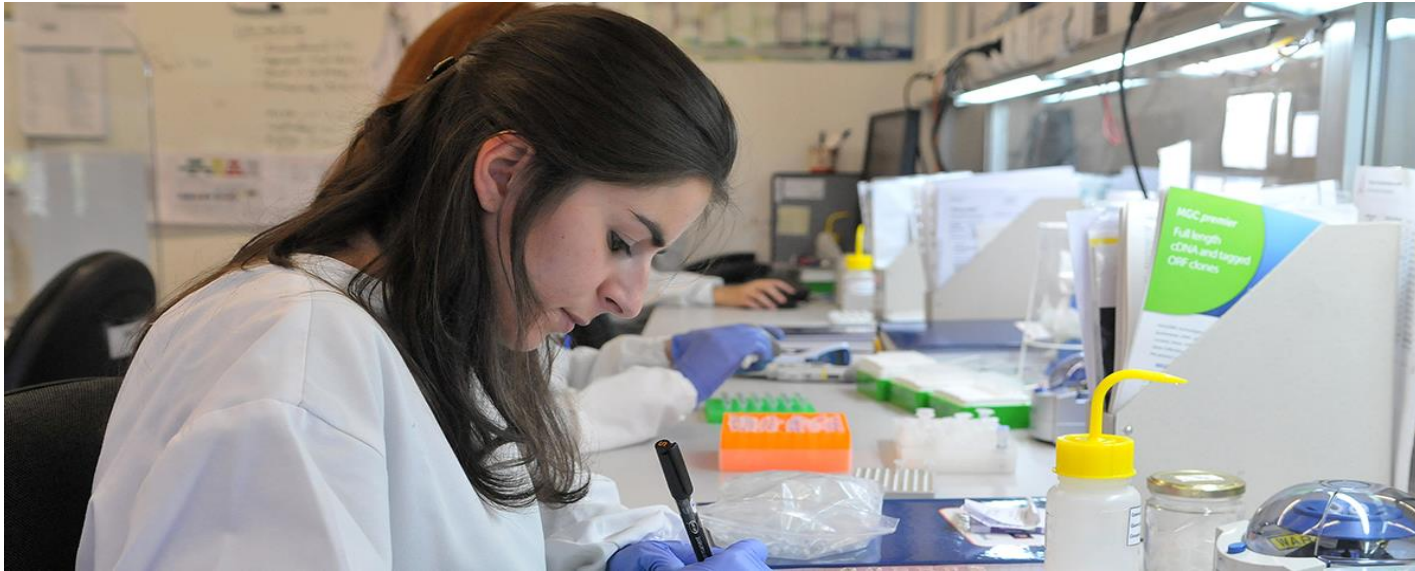

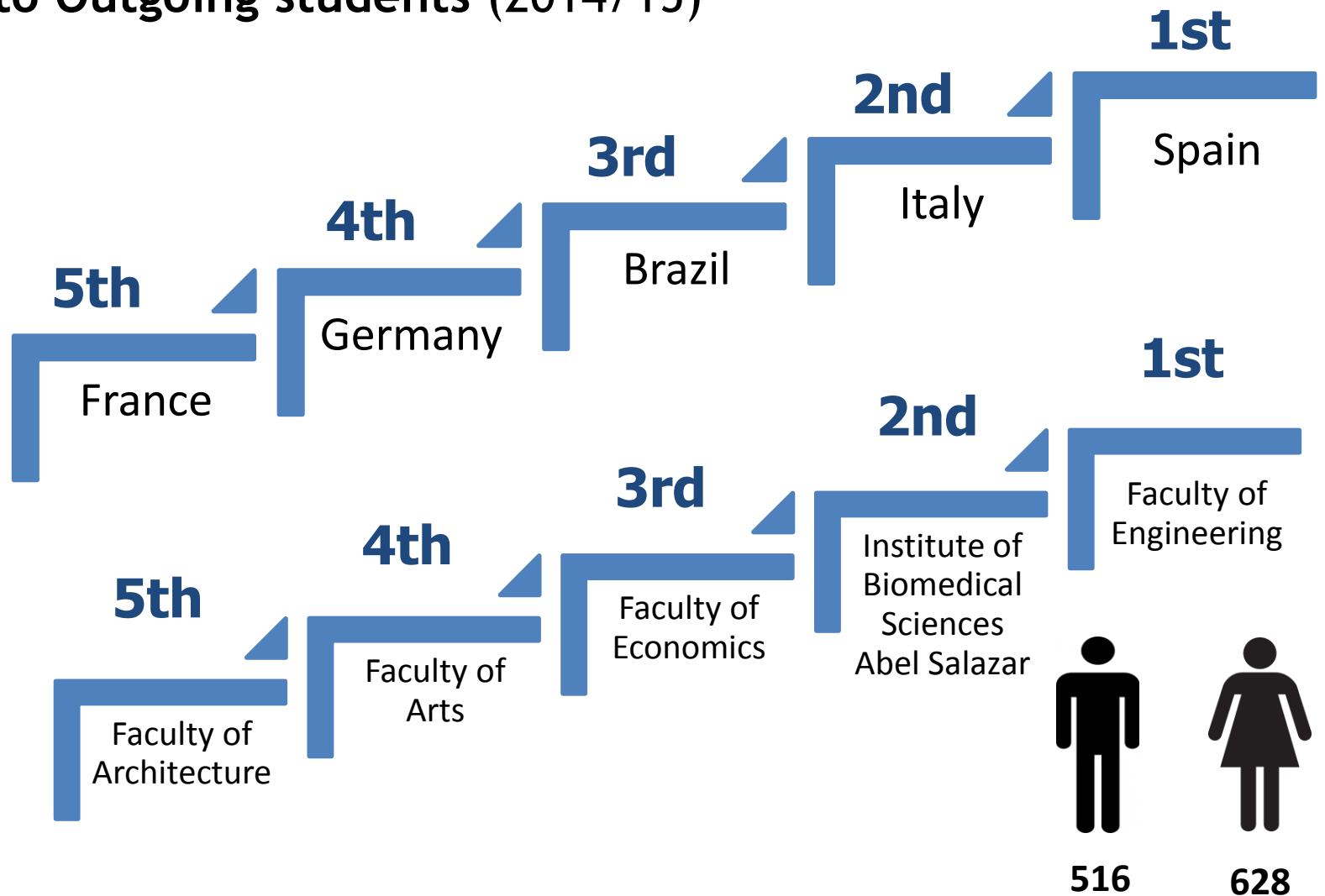

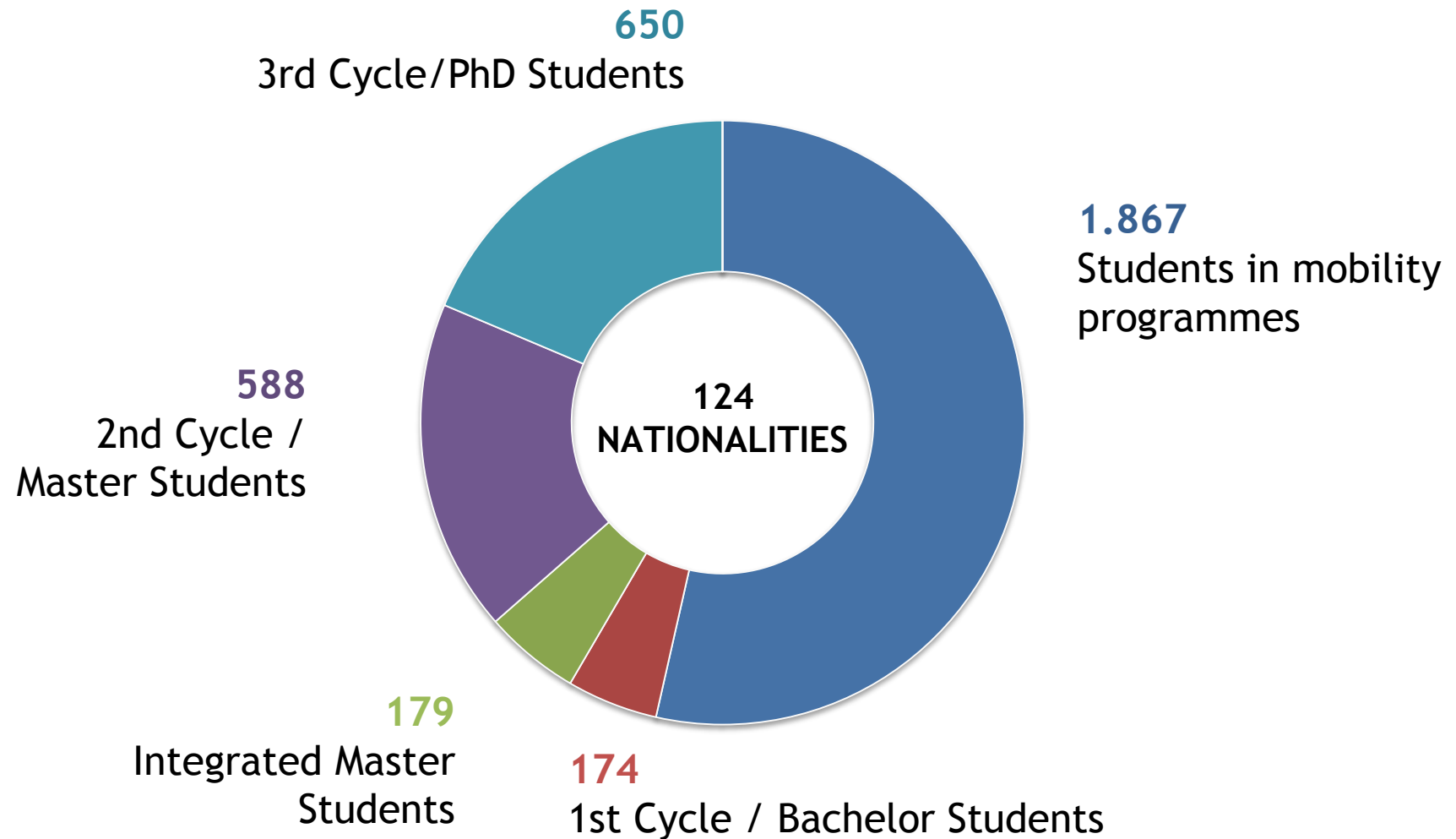

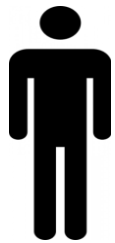
