

Single, double and triple occupancy is offered. This facility is located about 20 minutes by tram from the city centre. The residence offers standard or standard plus rooms.

ESTIMATED COSTS OF LIVING

Below is an estimate of the cost of living in the Czech Republic per month. The actual cost can differ depending on the student's life style. Please note that all costs below are subject to change without prior notice.

Housing	2 500 – 5 530 CZK (100 - 225 EUR)	
Meals	6 200 CZK (237 EUR)	Subsidized student meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) are available at the restaurants within the Jan Opletal Halls of Residence and Kampus Palace.
Transportation	300 – 800 CZK (12 - 30 EUR)	ODIS card (public transport card) - a ticket valid for 1, 3 or 5 months uploaded to a public transport card; price depending on the kind of selected travel zone; for students up to 26 years old.

Buddy system	<p>All international students may ask to be assigned to a “buddy” who will help them to adjust smoothly to the life and culture of the Czech Republic.</p> <p>The buddies usually pick up the international students at the train station in Ostrava and take them to the accommodation.</p> <p>The buddy system is operated by the international student club ESN Ostravská (www.esn-ostravska.cz/buddy).</p>

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Accommodation scholarship	<p>International students have a possibility to apply for an accommodation scholarship before the set deadline. The students must study a full quarter at the university and be physically in the Czech Republic. Student must also have a Czech bank account.</p>
