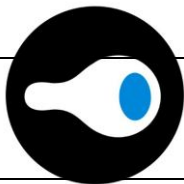


Application procedure:

Application guidelines	<p>Applicants must be officially nominated by their home universities.</p> <p>Applications will be reviewed by faculty coordinators. Candidates will be informed about the status of their applications within 2 weeks from the deadline.</p> <p>Only complete applications submitted within the deadline will be reviewed.</p>

Health insurance	Incoming exchange students are highly advised to arrive in Poland with a valid health insurance that covers medical assistance within the territory of Poland. Exchange students can also buy private insurance in Poland.

Visa:

Visa	<p>All EU or EFTA citizens are allowed to stay within the territory of Poland up to 90 days. After that period, they are obliged required to register at the Immigration Office of Wielkopolska Voivodeship Office in Poznań.</p> <p>All applicants who do not come from EU or EFTA countries should obtain a student visa before entering Poland. Please contact the Polish Embassy/Consulate nearest to you for more information.</p> <p>UAP will issue all documents required for applying for the proper student visa.</p>
