<b>Tuition Fees</b>	No tuition fees applicable to Erasmus students.
<b>Romanian Language Courses</b>	Most of our courses are studio based and all the teachers or their assistants speak English. For the Theoretical Subjects, each teacher could make arrangements with the foreign students wishing to attend the theoretical courses. In case the incoming students wish to learn Romanian language: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The French Institute in Cluj-Napoca provides Romanian Language Courses for French language native speakers;</li> <li>• For Italian students, the Italian Cultural Centre could offer support for learning Romanian;</li> <li>• The Erasmus+ Office could arrange basic courses of Romanian language in case there will be incoming students wishing to learn Romanian.</li> </ul>
<b>Airport pick-up service</b>	Students should take the Cluj-Napoca Direct bus service (number 5 or 8) from the airport - 4 RON (~1EUR), or the taxi service – average cost: up to 30 RON (~7 EUR); But the Erasmus+ Office together with ESN Cluj-Napoca do their best to arrange the picking up of the incoming students at the airport.

<b>Transcripts</b>	Transcripts of results will be introduced in the Learning Agreement of the incoming students in the section AFTER MOBILITY. The scanned copy of the Learning Agreement with all the 3 sections: BEFORE, DURING and AFTER mobility, plus the Certificate of attendance will be sent to the student and to the Erasmus+ contact person at the home institution, at the end of student's mobility. In case the home institution requires original copies, these will be sent by regular mail.
<b>Insurance</b>	Incoming students are advised to have the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) for studies abroad and also private travel and health insurance for the duration of their Erasmus studies / placement at Cluj-Napoca
