EVALUATION

50 % coursework (project)
50 % final test (virtual class)

5 missions to accomplish over the course of the programme, to finish with a **collaborative final project!**

INCLUDING EACH DAY

- **two hour-long language classes** (in large groups)
- **tutoring in small groups** of 2 or 3 students, to work on the different missions
- **individual, independent work**
- **cultural activities** to discover French culture, and virtual visits to discover local places of interest: Le Mans, the Loire Valley châteaux, the Le Mans 24 hour motor race...
- **intercultural activities**, to exchange with all students on campus...

- a computer, a microphone and a webcam
- a good Internet connection
